Seeing Stars

Charity Navigator, a leading evaluator of public charities, has awarded The Rotary Foundation its top rating of four stars.

To help people make intelligent donation choices, Charity Navigator provides free ratings of tax-exempt, U.S.-based charities that receive more than \$500,000 from public support. The nonprofit also looks at length of operation and program type before considering an organization for evaluation.

Currently, Charity Navigator evaluates the organizational efficiency, organizational capacity, and overall financial health of more then 5,000 charities.

"Less than a quarter of the charities we evaluate have received our highest rating, indicating that The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International outperforms the majority of nonprofits in America with respect to fiscal responsibility," says Trent Stamp, executive director of Charity Navigator, in the letter announcing RI's four-star rating.

A four-star rating indicates an exceptional financial performance. Three stars signify a good financial performance, two stars indicate a need for improvement, and one star denotes a poor performance. A rated organization not awarded any stars is considered exceptionally poor.

An organization's rating is based on its scores in seven categories. The overall score of a four-star charity ranges from 60 to 70. An organization is awarded no stars if its overall score is less than 25. The Foundation received an overall score of 60.92.
