Wind Energy

Last week, George Hoguet, a member of the Fair Trade Committee and Director of Mid Atlantic Operations of *NativeEnergy* spoke to us about wind energy.

Some interesting facts gathered during the meeting include:

- Our atmosphere is only about 30 miles wide.
- Gasses and pollutants (greenhouse gases) are effecting our ozone and rising the temperature.
- In ten years, it is projected that there will be no snows of Kilimanjaro.
- By drilling into the earth, researchers can very accurately read the bubbles and carbon dioxide levels in the ice to get the temperature at the time of freezing and the global warming effects.
- Never in the last 600,000 years were we anywhere near the CO² and heat levels that we are at today!
- Starting in 2004, there were four Class 4 hurricanes in the United States, 10 typhoons in Japan, and the first hurricane in Brazil. In 2005, there were three hurricanes in the Atlantic Ocean at the same time.
- 2005 was the warmest year on the plant... until 2006, which was at least the warmest year in the United States.
- In July 2006, every state was above normal temperatures.
- Rain is also effected by global warming causing much flooding and drought.
- Towns in Indonesia and places in London are severely flooding because of melting Antarctic shelves. If floods like that continue, starting at the end of the decade, places like South Philadelphia and The Philadelphia Airport could experience extreme flooding and eventually may no longer exist above water.
