Victoria, British Columbia



During my honeymoon, we stopped in Victoria, British Columbia. Right off the docks of our cruise ship, my husband and I wandered into a "Rotary Garden" and it prompted a brief photo opportunity. I thought it might be interesting to learn about what this dedication was for so I researched The Rotary Club of Victoria, BC. ~ Courtney

In early 1913, members of the Seattle Club (#4) and the Vancouver Club (61) brought the idea of Rotary to Victoria. Within months the Rotary Club of Victoria was established as Club #90. The Club met at the Empress Hotel for over 75 years before moving to its present location at the Princess Mary Restaurant.

Club 90 was responsible for the establishment of the Chamber of Commerce and what is now Tourism Victoria. In 1948, the Club sponsored the Tourist Bureau building which remains today on the Inner Harbour Causeway.

In 2003, the Club celebrated its 90th anniversary with more than a dozen celebratory activities including a formal banquet, the awarding of Paul Harris Fellowships to a number of local eminent citizens and the production of a Rotary insert for the two local newspapers.

As one of the first hundred clubs in Rotary, the Rotary Club of Victoria, BC, is proud to celebrate the 100th anniversary of Rotary International. Club 90's principal centennial project is the creation of a ROTARY welcome garden at the ocean/cruise ship terminals, which will be a permanent gift to the city and will welcome myriads of visitors, we hope for the next hundred years.
