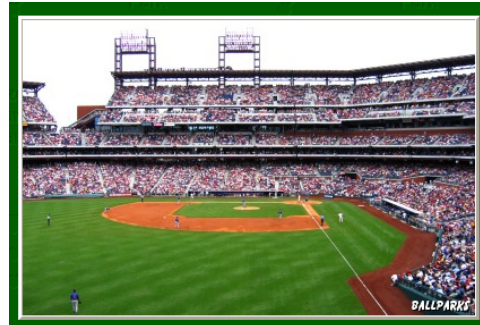

Five years ago "The co-operative" supermarkets in the UK embarked upon a truly co-operative venture with Kuapa Kokoo in Ghana and Divine Chocolates.

The Fair Trade social premium that villagers received has paid for 200 wells in remote locations, built and resourced the running of 7 schools, and provided mobile clinics so that health care is now being given locally for the co-operative's members and their families.
