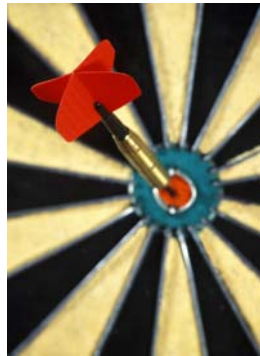

Let me introduce you to more of our Rotarians. Today, we will meet our new president, Nancy Geisel.

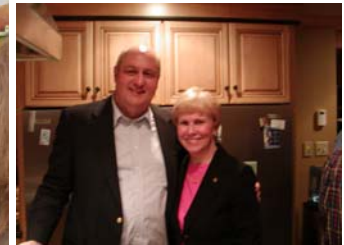
Nancy Geisel
