## CityTeam still cleaning Katrina's mess

**Media** – CityTeam Ministries' post-Katrina relief efforts received support from its relationship with Media Rotary.

The Rev. Larry Smooze, pastor of Reformation Lutheran Church and a Rotarian, presented CityTeam Director Richard Williams with \$1,900 from a free-will collection at a recent musical event.

"It's harder and harder to get the story out there," said Williams, "but don't quit now. There are people who need you."

CityTeam was among the first organizations on the ground and Media Rotarians were there less than a month after the storm, due to its association with CityTeam in Chester.

CityTeam has concentrated efforts in Bay St. Louis, Miss., completely rebuilding 30 homes, repairing 150 and has a goal of building 30 more. Williams said they have had continuing support from Williamson Trade School.

"There have been 50 kids or more who have come down. They can do an amazing amount of work in seven days," said Williams.

Rotarian Bill Strine has been going to Bay St. Louis regularly to update efforts. He brings the message back and knocks on countless corporate doors to raise funds.

CityTeam is the only organization still there. The support has dwindled. It's not good enough to rush in and leave," Strine said. "CityTeam volunteers go and stay and live in the community." They are rebuilding families, which is different than just rebuilding homes."

Williams said CityTeam, a national ministry, will continue making a difference. He added that although Hancock County in Mississippi is hundreds of miles from Delaware County, it is "in our backyard."

"It's not somebody else's problem," said Williams.
