Acme Register Tape

As of the end of June, we have completed 11 years of the Acme Register Tape Program.

22,552 Register tapes have been processed to provide \$7,886.51 to the Media Rotary Foundation. When we submit our receipts, a check, generated from Acme's Home Office is mailed directly to the Rotary Foundation.

This past year, we have fallen from our yearly average of \$716.96. We are currently at \$561.56 so, please bring in those register tapes!
