



Debbie Timblin, representing Middletown Township, shared with the Media Rotary on September 4, 2009 the Township's program to become a Clean Energy Community through the Pennsylvania Clean Energy Communities Campaign.

By becoming a Clean Energy Community, the Township anticipates reaping rewards in a number of ways. The Clean Energy Campaign is designed to reduce our dependency on fossil fuels by encouraging the entire community to support the production and use of clean, renewable energy. Through residents committing their homes and businesses to receive clean energy, they take another step towards reducing our dependency on fossil fuels and supporting forms of energy that will lessen the negative impact on the environment.

According to Ms. Timblin, in order for the Township to qualify for the program they need to receive commitments from 7% of the community (164 homes and businesses) before October 1st. In her report, Ms. Timblin informed the Rotarians that they need 31 more commitments before the deadline.
