Remembering Iverson Ankang, China

(continued from last week)

On that last day, Iverson handed me a bracelet of green jade stones – a special Chinese gift of friendship. In broken English, he said, *This is good luck.* I put the bracelet on, admiring its shine. He continued, *I think you always. I never forget you. I want you never forget me.* His eyes started to water, and he embraced me in a big hug. My mind clouded with shock and gratitude. And I could only smile. I had no idea I meant this much to him. I had never treated Iverson with any special attention; he was just the same as all my students. But he saw it differently. I encouraged him. I paid attention to him. I helped him believe in himself. Iverson, I don't think I could ever forget you.

My students treated me to dinner where, still choked up, they raised their glasses to me. They escorted me to my apartment, desperately

clinging to every moment they had. *Please don't forget us.* After saying our final goodbyes, I went into my apartment where my coworkers were waiting. Apparently equally dismayed by my departure, they had volunteered to help pack my clothes and accompany me to my train. So, in my last few hours in Ankang, we folded clothes, watched midnight Japanese cartoons and laughed together, before catching a three a.m. taxi to my train. They huddled outside, tears welling in their eyes, as I walked through the security gate, most likely to never see them again. And as they waved their last waves, I couldn't help but think, *It's time for me to say bye-bye...*

Dear Brendon...

You are the first foreign teacher, I very like you. You make me learn a lot of things. I want to say thanks for you.

When you left that evening, I cried the whole day, Thank you give me finally hug.

I always look at photos, I think you're very handsome! And you?

Thanks for you helping me. YOU ARE THE BEST ENGLISH TEACHER! I will never forget you!

You left those words my mother will never understand. "Remember happiness is the most important think in our life." Why the people around me can't be nice like you? I can't let my parents see my tears because of these things. They will be angry. They will criticize me.

When I was saluting, I was crying. I was thinking of the day you left. I don't know why. Now I cannot stand parting with others.

When I'm older I want to be a nice person like you. To help people who needs help. To do the really right things to the people around me.

I think you are my hero in my heart. I miss you everyday.
