**A message from Don Bak's Daughter -
Dated February 4, 2010.**

Hello! I wanted to let you all know about Dad. He went back to Riddle Village today and not to Bryn Mawr Rehab as we were anticipating/ hoping. This might be a good thing, being in a more familiar setting, where family and friends can see him more often.

Today is also his 80th birthday!!

He is not back to his apartment, but is on the skilled nursing floor, (room 417B) We will get a plan for PT/OT etc soon and hope that he can build his strength back up. He can have visitors any time, (as long as he is not at therapy or sleeping,) and that would be great for him. He is still very tired, weak, and often times not clear. He is not eating or drinking yet, due to trouble with swallowing, (neurological we think--it's coming back slowly) and still has a feeding tube. He can't even sit in a chair just yet, but hope that comes back with some more regular intensive PT. (right, Jeff?!!) He is much more alert, is talking much more, and has recognized everyone so far.

And, in the midst of dealing with Dad, we are also having to move my mother. She is having more difficulty getting around and requires more help (although it is very hard to get her to ask for it!). She is falling and stumbling much more now. She has moved to room 301 Monticello, and will have a new phone number that I don't know yet. But finding the time to do all this is the hard part.
